

Eltete TPM – EUDR Compliance Update

Dear Customer,

The EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR) will apply from **30 December 2026** for medium and large operators. The regulation covers certain wood-based products placed on or exported from the EU market and requires due diligence to ensure products are deforestation-free and legally sourced.

For packaging materials, EUDR generally applies only when the packaging itself is sold as the main product. Packaging used solely to protect, support, or transport other products is generally outside the scope of the Regulation.

Eltete TPM is actively preparing for compliance by reviewing product applicability, strengthening supply chain traceability, engaging suppliers, and establishing the necessary due diligence procedures and reporting processes.

Since 2019, Eltete TPM has maintained FSC® Chain of Custody certification, supporting responsible sourcing and supply chain transparency. While valuable, FSC certification does not replace EUDR requirements.

We appreciate our customers' and partners' efforts to prepare for EUDR implementation. There are still some open questions regarding the interpretation of the regulation and reporting. We are monitoring the situation and we are committed to act when clear guidelines are published. To avoid duplication of work, we kindly ask that this statement be accepted as our current EUDR status update.
